#### **Recommended Dilution Ratio**

- 1. To make 1 gallon of Ready-to-Use Cleaner: Mix 16 ozs. of concentrate with 112 ozs. water in a gallon container.
- 2. To make 1 quart of Ready-to-Use cleaner: Mix 4 ozs. of concentrate with 28 ozs. of water in a 32 oz. spray bottle.

### **Directions for Use**

- 1. Sweep, dust mop or vacuum before cleaning with PALLMANN® HARDWOOD FLOOR CLEANER.
- 2. Spray or mist a 4' X 6' area of your floor with the diluted cleaner and wipe with a pre-dampened microfiber mop. Wetting the mop helps loosen dirt on the floor surface and quickens the cleaning process. It is recommended to rinse your mop as it gets soiled during the cleaning process to avoid leaving a muddy residue behind.
- 3. To clean, simply move the mop back and forth. For stubborn spots, sticky spills and shoe marks, spray cleaner directly on the soiled area and wipe with a clean cloth or mop pad by hand if necessary.
- 4. For large areas, mix PALLMANN<sup>®</sup> HARDWOOD FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE in a commercial mop bucket at the recommended dilution ration (1:7).
