- Beater bars with stiff bristles – Can scratch finish
 - Plastic wheels – Always choose rubberized wheels
 - Heavy upright vacuums – Risk of damaging finish over time

 - Vacuum regularly to prevent grit scratching
 - Avoid dragging vacuums – lift over thresholds
 - Empty the dustbin frequently to maintain suction
